

RULES FOR MAINTAINING D.O.T. WELDING CARD

Once you have obtained a Connecticut Department of Transportation (D.O.T.) Welding Certification - **it is up to you to maintain it**

This means you must call Tom Lynch or Dan Furlani at the CT Department of Transportation Division of Materials Testing (860) 258-0329 every six (6) months, whether you are welding or not, to maintain the D.O.T. welding card.

The CT D.O.T. Welding Certification is good for two (2) years after the date of issue. **At the two-year expiration date, the card gets mailed to the Department of Transportation to be re-issued.** Re-issue of the card is at the discretion of the State Inspector. The card is the property of the CT D.O.T. If you are welding on multiple jobs between the six (6) month intervals, **you must call each time you change contractors.** Failure to do this may jeopardize your certification. The D.O.T. has these rules in order to track welders that hold this certification. They also have the right to revoke the welder's card at any time.

The test at MISTRAS/ITI cost the Union \$300.00. The Union will pay for the initial test after completing the journeyman upgrade class. If you fail to follow these rules and allow this certification to lapse or run out, you will be responsible to pay for the retest.
